

DON'T GET HOOKED

(Ages 6 and older)

PURPOSE

To help family members better avoid Satan's temptations

MATERIALS

- Scriptures
- A fish lure (or picture below)

SONG SUGGESTION

• "Dare to Do Right" page 158 in the Children's Songbook

LESSON IDEAS

- 1. Hold up the fish lure (or picture below) and ask, "Why would a hungry fish want to eat something that has hooks on it?"
 - a. Explain that when a fisherman casts the hook into the water he reels in the line so the lure moves through the water and looks like something a fish wants to eat. If the fish is not careful he will take a bite and get hooked!
 - b. You may want to show your family a portion of this <u>video</u> demonstrating catching fish with a lure.
- 2. Explain the following about Satan:
 - a. Satan is a master 'fisherman' who also uses lures. He makes sin and misery look like happiness.
 - b. He's been 'fishing' for thousands of years and has 'hooked' many people.
 - c. Ask your family to give some examples of sins that get us 'hooked'. (Smoking, drinking, lying, stealing, drugs, pornography, etc.)
- 3. Ask your family, "So how do we know if something is good or just one of Satan's dangerous temptations?"
 - a. Help your family understand that if something looks good or fun, but doesn't agree with Heavenly Father's commandments, we can always know it is one of Satan's lures!
 - b. Read and discuss Nephi's promise to those who keep the commandments (1 Nephi 15:24).
- 4. You may want to read or re-tell one of the following:
 - a. Story, Think First, Act Fast (for older children)
 - b. Story, Winner! (for younger children)

- 5. You may want to read and discuss this with your family:
 - a. Idea List: Overcoming Temptation
- 6. Testify that if we always follow the teachings of Jesus Christ we will never be hooked by Satan's lures.

ACTIVITY IDEAS

- Role play different situations of temptation (being offered drugs, stealing something, etc.) and allow children to practice their response.
- Go fishing as a family to a nearby river, lake or fish farm.
