

JOSEPH IN THE SACRED GROVE

(Ages ~7 and older)

PURPOSE

• To help family members better understand Joseph Smith's First Vision and what we can learn from it

MATERIALS

• Scriptures for family members

SUGGESTED SONG

• "Joseph Smith's First Prayer" #26 in Hymns

LESSON IDEAS

- 1. It might be helpful for younger children to start the lesson by watching a short video giving some of the background of Joseph Smith: <u>Joseph Smith and His Family</u> (2 minutes)
- 2. Show video: <u>Joseph Smith</u>: <u>Prophet of the Restoration Pt. 1</u> (14 minutes)
 - a. A portion of this video shows the operation Joseph had on his leg as a young boy. You may want to discuss that with your family also.
- 3. Read or explain in your own words Joseph Smith History 1:3-20. Depending on the age of your children, discuss some of the things Joseph learned from the First Vision:
 - a. Jesus and Heavenly Father are real
 - b. Jesus and Heavenly Father are two separate people
 - c. Heavenly Father knows us by name
 - d. Heavenly Father answers sincere prayer
 - e. The true church was not then on the earth
- 4. Testify of the truthfulness of Joseph Smith's First Vision.

ACTIVITY

- Younger children may enjoy putting this puzzle together: <u>Joseph Seeks Wisdom in the</u> Bible
- The Bible was a big influence in Joseph's life. His family often read in it as a family. Families with older children may enjoy taking this quiz to see how much they know about the Bible.
