

HOLD UP YOUR LIGHT!

PURPOSE

To encourage listeners to better live the gospel so as to be examples of Christ to those around them

MATERIALS

- Scriptures
- A flashlight
- A paper and pencil for each person

LESSON IDEAS

- 1. Prior to the lesson:
 - a. Turn the flashlight on and hide it somewhere in the room where the light is bright enough that the group will not notice that the flashlight is on.
- 2. Tell listeners that you have hidden a flashlight somewhere in the room. Ask them to look around the room (without getting up from where they are sitting) and see if they can see where it is.
- 3. Have someone to turn out the lights in the room.
 - a. Ask listeners to look around and see if they now can see where the flashlight is.
 - b. Ask, "Why were you able to see it much more easily with the lights turned off?"
- 4. Explain that we are living in a world that is becoming darker. As the world darkens, our examples will become much brighter to those around us.
- 5. Read 3 Nephi 18:24.
 - a. Ask, "What is the Savior asking us to do?"
 - b. Ask, "What is the light we are to hold up?"
 - c. Ask, "How do we hold up that light?" (By doing the things Jesus would do)
- 6. Testify of the importance of being a light to those around us. Challenge each person to write down one thing he/she can do this week to hold up the light of the Savior.
