

## SEALED TOGETHER FOREVER

## PURPOSE

To illustrate the importance of:

- 1. Being sealed together as a family in the temple
- 2. Living in a way to continue enjoying the blessings of the temple

## MATERIALS

- An envelope
- Photos of family members or cut-outs (below)
- A picture of a <u>temple</u>


## **LESSON**

1. Ask, "What is the most important organization on the earth?" (The family!) Explain that President Gordon B. Hinckley stated: "I believe the family to be the basic and most important unit of society" (*Ensign* August 1992, 5).

- 2. Hold up the cut-outs. Explain that Heavenly Father loves us so much that He has allowed us to live together in this life as families. Put the photos/cut-outs in the envelope.
- 3. Explain: "Someday every family member will die and will not be able to live together as a family in the next life unless they are sealed together." Shake the envelope until allow the cut-outs/photos to fall to the floor.
- 4. Explain that because Heavenly Father wants families to be together forever He has special buildings called temples where families can be sealed together. Show a picture of a temple.
- 5. Put the family cut-outs back into the envelope, lick the seal and close it. Shake the envelope to show that none of the cut-outs will fall out. Explain that when families are sealed and keep the commandments, Heavenly Father has promised us that they can all be together forever.
- 6. Discuss some of the things all family members must do to allow them to be sealed in the temple and to continue to qualify for those blessings:
  - a. Pray
  - b. Attend church
  - c. Live the Word of Wisdom
  - d. Pay a full tithing
  - e. Follow the prophet
  - f. Be morally clean
